

# HOOPESTON AREA HIGH SCHOOL

## SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM

**Objective** - To create an opportunity for students to recover credits to stay on track to graduate.

**Goals** - To offer English and Math instruction from a highly qualified (certified) teacher for credit recovery toward graduation requirements. To offer credit recovery from an accredited online program (for subjects other than Math).

### Math Credit Recovery Classes

- Classes will meet from Tuesday, May 28th through Friday, June 14, 2024. Classes will run from 8:30-11:30 each day, Monday through Friday. A minimum of 10 students for each class is necessary for the class to be offered. There is a maximum of 20 seats available for each class.

### English Credit Recovery Classes

- Classes will meet from Tuesday, May 28th through Friday, June 14, 2024. Classes will run from 8:30-11:30 each day, Monday through Friday. A minimum of 10 students for each class is necessary for the class to be offered. There is a maximum of 20 seats available for each class.

### Credit Recovery Through Edgenuity

- There will be two sessions of credit recovery offered through Project Success, each lasting three weeks. Students can sign up for one or both. The first session will be every weekday from Tuesday, May 28th through Friday, June 14th, 2024. The second session will meet every weekday from Monday, June 17th through Wednesday, July 3rd. (There will be no Project Success on Wednesday, June 19th, due to Juneteenth Day). Edgenuity classes will run from 8:30-12:00 each morning and 1:00-3:00 each afternoon. Any student choosing to stay for both sessions will have lunch provided by Project Success. **Edgenuity is unique in that a student can make up to 3 credits (6 semester classes) over the course of a session, and once a student completes the credit(s), they are no longer required to attend credit recovery.**

A minimum of 5 students are necessary for online credit recovery to be offered. A maximum of 20 seats is available for the online credit recovery class.

There is no fee for summer school.

**\*Course offerings may be adjusted due to staffing.**

**Attendance Policy For Math and English Courses** - There is a total of 42 hours of seat time that are required with some outside work also in order to recover a semester of Math or English. For the online Edgenuity classes, all work must be done on campus during class time.

A list of the requirements is attached so that all students and their parents understand the obligations of each student. Both students and parent/guardian(s) should sign the attached summer school requirements sheet and return it to the HS Office.

Students will be held to high attendance and behavior standards. Please read the requirements carefully to ensure all parties understand the expectations.

## **SUMMER SCHOOL CREDIT RECOVERY REQUIREMENTS**

1. All regular Hoopston Area High School Student Handbook rules are in effect.
2. Regardless of the reason: illness, emergencies, misbehavior, etc., a student may be absent **no more than five (5) hours during the entire summer session** for each semester class in order to receive credit.
3. When a student is tardy to class five minutes or less; he/she will have to make up that time at the end of the day. If the time is not made up, the student will lose credit for an entire hour.
4. When a student is tardy to school for more than five minutes; he/she will lose credit for an entire hour.
5. When a discipline matter becomes severe enough to warrant removal of the student from the room, the student may be sent home and this will be counted as an unexcused absence. The students will lose credit for the entire hour(s).
6. Students should stay in the designated classroom and areas (hallways, restroom, break areas, etc.) at all times.

7. All students should enter and exit the building through the HS main doors next to the HS office. Math classes will meet in Mrs. Gondzur's Room, and English will meet in Dr. Bradney's Room. Project Success classes will be located in the HS science hallway. Do not enter the building in the morning until the doors have been opened by a summer school teacher or the principal.
8. Breaks will be given at only designated times. Students must stay in the designated area. Students may not go outside during any of the breaks
9. As long as it does not become a problem, food and drink may be allowed with teacher discretion. Students who stay for both morning and afternoon times for Project Success will be provided a sack lunch to eat in between sessions.
